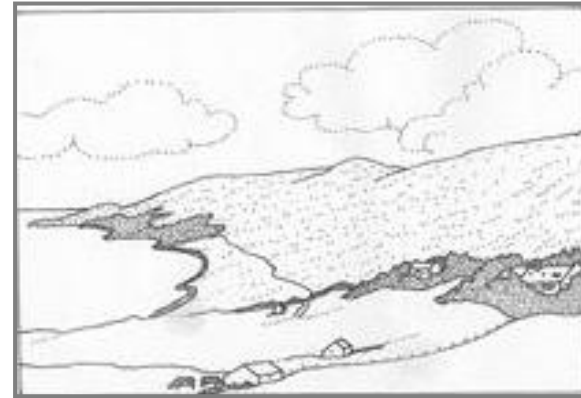

- You can drive to **BADRALLACH**, leave your car and walk 5 miles to the Secondary School building on Scoraig where we will meet up, or
- You can take a bus from Inverness to **ULLAPOOL** where a lift can be arranged to Scoraig.
